	<p>Mental:</p> <p>Main: Solve capacity word problems</p>	<p>Mental:</p> <p>Main: Revise how we have been looking at measurement over the last few lessons Explain to children that we will be learning to solve capacity word problems today Emphasise the importance of imagining the word problem to help you Model how to use a drawing to represent and help solve a word problem for 4 sample word problems e.g. for 'One tank has 10 litres in it and another tank has 5 litres in it. How much do they have in them in total?' you could draw the two tanks</p>	<p>Lower ability – one-step word problems with all four operations</p>	<p>Children to explain their working out for the problems that they solved to a partner</p>
