## Capacity word problems

1. A gardener collects some rain-water in 5 tubs. Each tub has 5 litres of water in it. How much water does he have in total?
2. A pot has 50 ml of syrup in it. Dad uses 10 ml . How much syrup will be left in the pot?
3. There are 20 litres of petrol in the tank of a truck. The driver adds another 10 litres. How much petrol will be in the truck now?
4. The volume of tea in a flask is 2 litres. Two painters share the flask equally. How much tea will they each get?

To access the 3 complete worksheets (including answers) at 3 levels of difficulty:

- one-step word problems with all four operations
- as above, but also two-step problems with addition and subtraction
- all two-step word problems with all four operations
