

Clockwise and Anticlockwise worksheet

- 1) Jack was looking at the **beach**. He turns **1 quarter turn clockwise**. What will he be looking at now?
- 2) Jack was looking at the **desert**. He turns **1 quarter turn anti-clockwise**. What will he be looking at now?
- 3) Jack was looking at the **mountains**. He turns **1 quarter turn clockwise**. What will he be looking at now?
- 4) Jack was looking at the **forest**. He turns **1 quarter turn anti-clockwise**. What will he be looking at now?
- 5) Jack was looking at the **beach**. He turns **1 half turn anti-clockwise**. What will he be looking at now?

- 6) Jack was looking at the **desert**. He turns **1 half turn clockwise**. What will he be looking at now? **Answer: Mountains**
- 7) Jack was looking at the **mountains**. He turns **2 quarter turns anti-clockwise**. What will he be looking at now? **Answer: Desert**
- 8) Jack was looking at the **forest**. He turns **3 quarter turns clockwise**. What will he be looking at now? **Answer: Desert**
