	<p>Mental:</p> <p>Main: Use ordinal numbers</p>	<p>Mental:</p> <p>Main: Have ten children come and stand at the front of the class. Ask how could we describe their position? What position is ... in? What about ...? Explain that 1st, 2nd etc are ordinal numbers – they tell us about the order things are in Show children numbers (1st, 2nd etc) and words (first, second etc) Have children stand in three lines of ten. Give them cards to get in to order</p>	<p>Have shapes with their names and ordinal number words on board throughout lesson</p> <p>Lower ability – Set of shapes at top of page (below). Complete two types of sentence e.g. 'the 1st / first shape is a ____ ____.' and 'the grey square is ____ / ____.'</p> 	<p>Give children a card with an ordinal number on it</p>
