## Word problems

1) Class 3 normally has thirty pupils in it. On Tuesday there were two children off sick. How many children were in Class 3 on Tuesday?
2) In the park five children can sit at a table. There are twenty children in the park. How many tables will they need so that they can all sit down?
3) Class 6 normally has twenty-four children. On Friday they had three extra children who were not able to go on a school trip. How many children did Class 6 have on Friday?
4) Each desk in a class has two chairs. How many chairs would ten desks have?

To access the 4 complete worksheets (including answers) with 11 questions on each, at these levels of difficulty:

- one-step word problems, using all four operations
- as above, but also two-step addition and subtraction problems
- two-step word problems, using all four operations
