The sound (ar) is nearly always represented by the letters ar, like in the words below.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'carton, c ... a ... r ... t ... o ... n'

A **carton** (car/ton) is a cardboard container for milk or fruit juice.

In a **cartoon** (car/toon) all of the characters are drawn.

A **market** (mar/ket) has stalls that sell things.

A **partner** (part/ner) is someone who you work with.

Harvest (har/vest) time is when farmers pick fruit and dig up vegetables.

A **carol** (car/ol) is a song that people sing at Christmas.

Regard (re/gard) is another word for look.

You wear a **harness** (har/ness) when you go rock-climbing to stay safe.

Marmalade (mar/ma/lade) is orange jam.

A **barcode** (bar/code) is what a person scans at the till to get the price.
