## Prefixes with hyphens

When a prefix ends with the same letter that the base words begins with, a hyphen is normally used. For example, co ends in o and operate starts with o.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'co-operate, c ... o ... - ... o ... p ... e ... r ... a ... t ... e'

To **co-operate** with someone means to work with them.

*co-operate co-operate*

To **co-ordinate** an event means to organise it.

*co-ordinate co-ordinate*

To **co-author** a book means to write it with someone else.

*co-author co-author*

If you **co-own** something, you share ownership of it with other people.

*co-own co-own*

To **re-enter** a place means to come back into it.

*re-enter re-enter*

To **re-educate** someone means to teach them something again.

*re-educate re-educate*

To **re-examine** something means to look at it again.

*re-examine re-examine*

To **re-evaluate** something means to think about it again.

*re-evaluate re-evaluate*

To **re-energise** someone means to increase his or her energy levels.

*re-energise re-energise*

To **re-explain** something means to explain it again.

*re-explain re-explain*
