The sound (us) is usually represented by the letters **ous** at the end of **adjectives** of more than one syllable, like in the words below.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'odious, o ... d ... i ... o ... u ... s'

Odious (o/di/ous) is another word for hateful or disgusting.

If a rock is **porous (por/ous)**, it has holes in it that let water through.

Aqueous (a/que/ous) is another word for watery.

If something is **arduous (ar/du/ous)**, then it is difficult and tiring to do.

To be **callous (cal/lous)** means to have no concern for other people.

A **copious (co/pi/ous)** amount is a very large amount.

Heinous (hei/nous) means really evil.

Igneous (ig/ne/ous) rocks are formed when lava cools down.

To be **jealous (jea/lous)** is to be unhappy because of what someone else has.

To have an **ominous (o/mi/nous)** feeling means you expect something bad.
